

St. James' Church Implication in Slavery, 1810-1827

An Act for the Gradual Abolition of Slavery (1799)

In Act for the gradual abolition of Slavery.

Bet encelled by the people, the state of sew Sork represented in lenate and Spembly That any Child born of a slave within this State after the fourth day of July next, shall be deemed and adjudged to be born for Rounded nevertheless that such Child shall be the swant of the legal proprietor of his or her mother, wintil such servantifa male shall arrive at the age of twenty right years, and if a smale at the age of Twenty five years.

And be it further enacted, That such proprietor his, her, or thur Seins or Upigns shall be entitled to the service of such Child until he or she shall arrive to the age aforesaid, in the same manner as if such Child had been bound to service by the verseers of the Bor.

And beit further enacted, That every person being an Inhabi tant of this State who shall be entitled to the source of a thild born after the fourth day of July as afores aid, shall within nine months after the birth of such Child cause to be dele wered to he blech of the tity or town, whereof such person shall be an Inhabitant, a contificate in writing containing the name and addition of such master or mustres, and the name age, and set of every child so born, which certificate shall be, by the said Clerk recorded in a Book to be by him for that purpose provided, which record shall be good and sufficient evidence of the age of such bhild, And the blert of such bity or Town shall receive from said person Twelve Cents for way bhild so registered, and if any such person neglets to make a return of every such thild as afores said to said black within nine months after the Bish thereof, such person shall fafiet and pay Five Dollars forevery such offence, to be such for and recovered by the Clerk of the city or Town in which such person resides,


Sojourner Truth (Isabella Bomfree) 1797-1883 enslaved in this diocese
